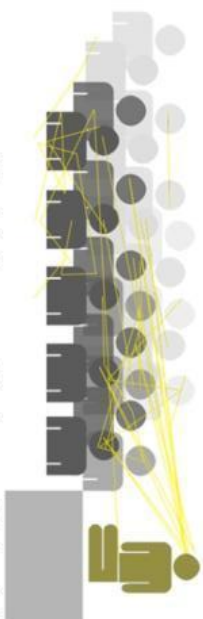
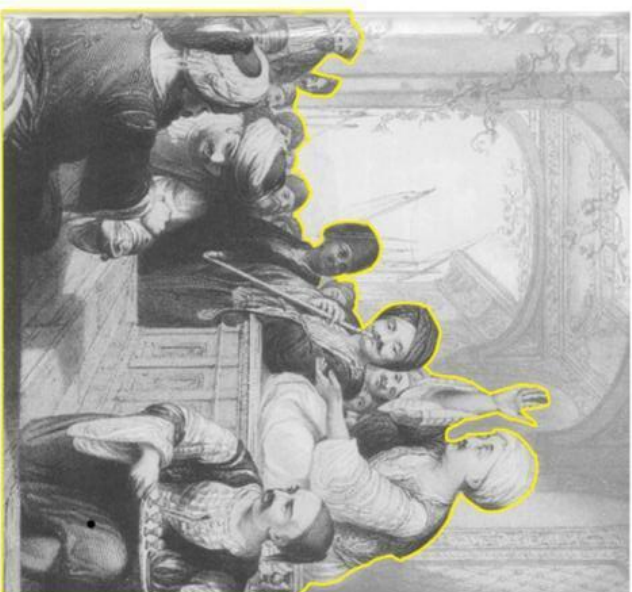
AGORA

"gathering place" or "assembly". The agora was the center of athletic, artistic, spiritual and political life of the city.

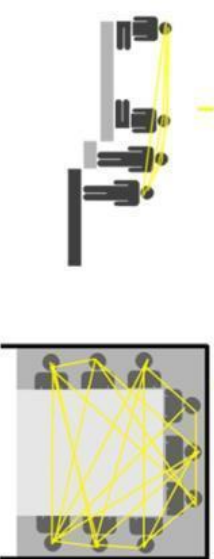
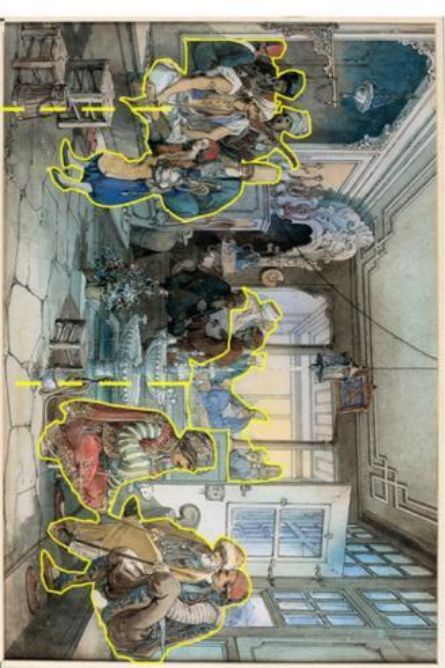


COFFEEHOUSE

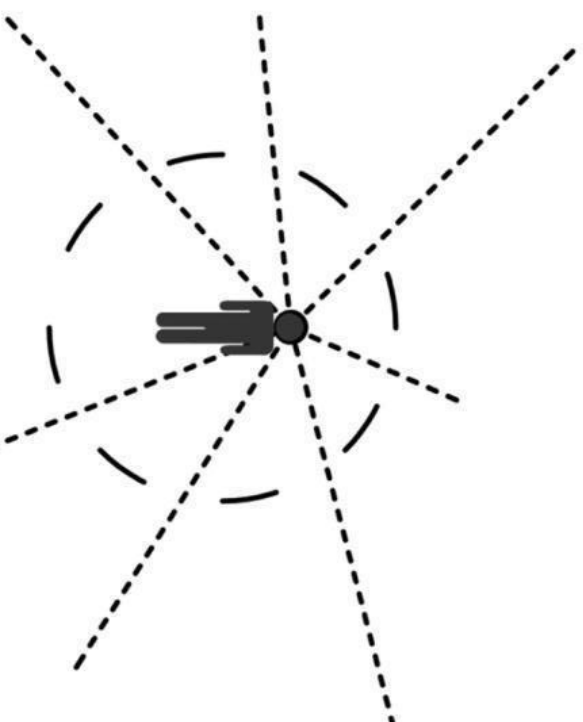
Horizontal and vertical surfaces create leafs
